THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SOUTHERN BRANCH OF THE NATIONAL PALACE MUSEUM AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM IN CHIAYI: PERCEPTION AND ATTITUDE OF CHIAYI CITIZENS

Abstract

In 2001 the proposal of building up the Southern Branch of the National Palace Museum (SNPM) has been initiated. It took almost 15 years to complete the SNPM.
